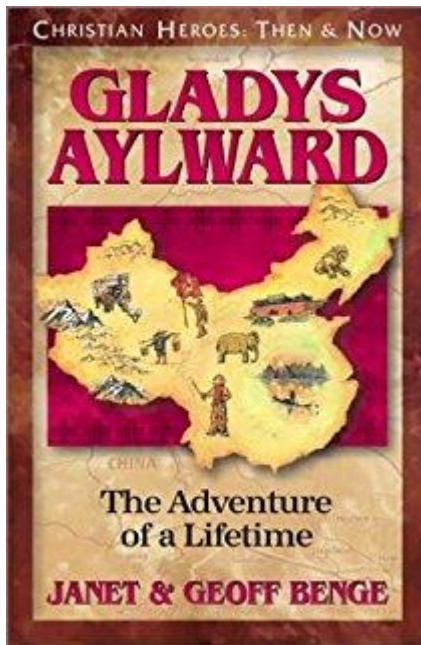


7th Grade PACE Summer Reading Assignment 2017

While reading the book, keep a composition notebook (or a spiral notebook) with the following information: (The notebook should be kept in the order below.)

- I. Title, Author, Picture representing the book
- II. Create a flow chart or an ordered list to show how Gladys gets to China originally.
- III. Main Character – 1-2 paragraphs describing how God prompts Gladys to become a missionary.
- IV. List of 8 characters that are important to the story. Include the following:
 - A. Details of how the character is important to the story.
 - B. One quote from the character OR a physical description of the character.
- V. Vocabulary – keep a list of at least 10 vocabulary words from the book. These should either be words in which you are unfamiliar or words that you find interesting.
 - A. Write the word;
 - B. Copy the sentence;
 - C. List the page number;
 - D. Give the dictionary definition;
 - E. Illustrate the word.
- VI. Journal Entries (10 journal entries) Write 10 journal entries as if you are Gladys. Describe important events that occurred, conflicts, or people that she met that were important in her story. (Each journal entry should be 7-10 sentences in length.)
- VII. Pick a Bible verse that best represents the novel.
